



## **ADMINISTRATIVE ISSUANCE**

Title: Cyclist Safety Decals

### **I. Background**

The Office of Taxicabs (“Office”) establishes procedures based on the provisions of Title 31 of the DCMR, including those which ensure the safety of cyclists traveling on public roads and of passengers exiting taxicabs.

### **II. Purpose**

To ensure that cyclist safety decals are displayed in all District taxicabs.

### **III. Policy**

Each taxicab licensed by the Office shall display cyclist safety decals on the windows of its rear passenger doors. One (1) decal shall be placed at the bottom right inside corner of the right rear passenger window, and one (1) decal shall be placed on the bottom left inside corner of the left rear passenger window. One (1) pair of original decals, and, upon request, one (1) pair of replacement decals, shall be provided by the Office free of charge for each vehicle.

The cyclist safety decal shall appear as follows:

### **VI. Procedures**

All taxicab owners shall pick up their decals from the Office by October 15, 2015, and shall affix the decals as required by October 31, 2015, provided however, that each taxicab company and association may pick up the decals required for its associated independent vehicles. Companies and associations are encouraged to pick up additional decals and make them available to unaffiliated independent owners. Independent owners may pick up their decals at the Office or from another taxicab company or association.
